Palm Springs

The Palm Springs style is all about creating cohesion between the indoors & outdoors. The style is breezy in design, yet solid in structure, predominantly created with materials such as breeze blocks and large pavers that can be integrated from the inside out.

With outdoor greenery and gardens catered to a dry climate, the Palm Springs style is perfect for the harsh Australian weather. Rich in materiality, with a natural colour palette, the Palm Springs tones are reminiscent of the Californian desert flora, with bold pops of coral and citrus yellow. The decor, however, is more refined, with a focus on clean lines and a more minimal approach. The Palm Springs style lets the relationship with the outdoor landscape do the talking.
