## BRICKWORKS ANNOUNCES RESTRUCTURE OF WESTERN AUSTRALIAN BRICK OPERATIONS

In line with comments made at the recent half yearly results presentation on 22 March, Brickworks Limited (ASX: BKW) today announced that it will rationalise its' manufacturing operations in Western Australia, with the closure of Plant 3 at Cardup.

This follows the closure of Plant 2 at Cardup and the Waterloo plant in 2009 and brings the total capacity closed to 60 million standard brick equivalents (SBE's), representing 25% of Brickworks manufacturing capacity in Western Australia.

Plant 3 at Cardup will cease operations in July 2012, however will not be dismantled until the property is redeveloped in future years, allowing flexibility to re-start the plant should conditions warrant.

The majority of products currently made at Cardup will be transferred to the more modern Malaga manufacturing plant, increasing utilisation and efficiency of this operation. The Malaga Plant has the flexibility to produce a wide range of contemporary, high quality products.

Mr Lindsay Partridge, Managing Director of Brickworks Limited, said: "These measures have been taken in response to the structural changes in the market and the continued subdued residential construction activity. The facilities at Bellevue, Armadale and Malaga will provide a sustainable, efficient and appropriately sized manufacturing operation that will enhance returns in the Western Australian brick business."
