Sustainably-grown, Jarrah and Karri coastal decking boards excel in harsh marine environments.

Australia's coastal locations are notoriously tough on building materials. For well over a century, two Australian timber species – Jarrah and Karri – have been widely used in wharf and jetty timbers, pilings and other engineered structures. These iconic timbers have an enviable record

of durability, stability and performance in the most demanding environments, including the 1.8km Busselton Jetty, the longest pier in the Southern Hemisphere, built in 1865.

Coastal Decking boards are more substantial than conventional domestic decking timbers in both thicknesses and widths. They are commonly available in random packs and in some instances up to 6.0 metres. Both timbers are readily workable with standard tools and accept conventional fastening systems and finishes.

Sustainable and Certifiable

All Auswest Timbers' Jarrah and Karri sawlogs are sourced from the WA Forest Products Commission, the state government authority responsible for the sustainable harvesting and regeneration of public forests. The Commission and Auswest Timbers operate under nationally and internationally recognised forestry certification programs, including the Australian Forestry Standard, a world class forestry standard endorsed by the foremost

assessor of sustainable forest management, the Programme for Endorsement of Forest Certification (PEFC). Chain of Custody certification is also available.





Jarrah

Elizabeth Quay, Perth, Western Australia

Jarrah decking was specified for the extensive boardwalks that distinguish Elizabeth Quay, a \$A440m mixed-use development on the north shore of Perth's Swan River. As well as pedestrian traffic, the boardwalks will carry occasional vehicles including trucks. The designers specified Jarrah decking throughout in 42 mm thickness and board widths from 130 mm to 270 mm. The Swan River is tidal and therefore saline but Jarrah has a long history of exemplary performance along this waterway in wharves, jetties and other engineered structures.



Karri

Pier 70, Paynesville, Victoria

As part of the extensive refurbishment of this waterside restaurant, a new low-level deck was constructed using Auswest Karri, both substructure and decking in 2008, and continues to give exceptional performance. The designers specified 35 mm thick Karri boards in 190 mm width for the new deck. Pier 70 is located on the Gippsland Lakes, Australia's largest navigable inland waterway system. The new deck overlooks a wharf which was previously constructed in Auswest Karri – both substructure and decking – in 2008 and continues to give exceptional performance. The designers specified 35 mm thick Karri boards in 190 mm width for the new deck. Although the Lakes system is fed by a number of rivers it is also open to the sea and is therefore saline. The waterside areas are also prone to flooding, and the existing wharf has stood the test of time.
